If you have a query about the following, please contact the Head of that Department:

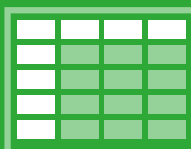
- Any of the above that have not been resolved

Homework at WPSfG:

Here at WPSfG homework plays a key role in your child's learning. Our aim for homework tasks to consolidate and build upon lessons taught, with knowledge and skills at the forefront.

In Key Stage 3, students have revision tasks or practice tasks set as homework (these tasks alternate).

Revision homework will be creating and using a revision resource, such as self-quizzing, revision mind maps or flash cards etc. Practice homework may take different forms. For example, exam style questions, short multiple practice questions, reading comprehension tasks and online task completion.

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Guidelines:

- English, Maths and Science (core subjects) set homework weekly.
- PE, Music, French and Computing set homework in Week A. Geography, History, DT and Drama set homework in Week B.
- Art homework is given in the double lesson in either week A or B.
- Core subjects set homework on the allocated day (see the timetable below). For example, if in English class 8x/En3, there will be homework on a Friday; whereas if in English class 8y/En3, there will be homework on a Monday.
- Homework club is available every Tuesday and Thursday afterschool for 1 hour. This provides a quiet space with access to computers for students to complete homework.
